




Academic Session CActivity Prism July-December 2018

18 August 2018



16 October 2018


A State Level Seminar was designed by the Music Department to encourage self motivated cognitive enquiry into Contemporary Trends in Research in Music.


5 November 2018

To mark the Constitution Day, an episode of Rajya Sabha Series 'Samvidhan' was screened by Political Science Department.




28 November 2018


Planning forum screened a documentary 'Can Technology overcome Hunger?' to sensitize the students regarding role of technology in reducing food wastage.

Role of Mathematics in Daily life was projected through power point presentations. It was a joint venture of Mathematics and Computer Science Department and it proved to be a great learning experience for students.






Career Counselling Initiatives


A Tribute To Legends




Commerce Department Remembers Kalam




Festive Fervour



6 October 2018



28 November 2018


Green Initiative by Eco Club


To facilitate the movement of women on the highway of empowerment, specific endevours were made to sensitize the students regarding women issues.



Arya College, Ludhiana was founded in the days of the Indian freedom struggle with the aim of empowering the Indian youth by providing them education of the kind needed for the development of the nation. The Women Section of the college was also founded to empower women which has always been a particular concern of Arya Samaj. Throughout the decades since then, successive Managements and Principals have guided the college along the path of service to the nation through education.

It has been my privilege to be associated with this distinguished institution for the last twenty four years. As I approach the last semester of my service, I look back upon this long association and venture to share my reflections with my esteemed colleagues and students.



My career changed in a major way when I joined Arya College, Ludhiana in 1994 as an Assistant professor in the Chemistry Department. Until then, my career had been focused on research and I felt right at home in this type of work. But here in Arya College, I had my first experience of teaching and this brought its own rewards. The continual stream of youngsters passing through our classrooms kept my subject ever- fresh for me and imparting my knowledge to them turned out to be sheer joy. Interaction with them outside the classroom put me in touch with the problems and pre-occupations of present day youth. My senior colleagues in the Department were dedicated teachers and they were role models for me. There were also eclectic discussions with colleagues from other departments which added to the richness of the academic life.

Not that it was rosy all the way. One matter of concern has been the increasing indifference of the students towards their studies. I believe this to be a sign that the courses of study need to be made more relevant to their lives and more useful for their careers. The fall in admission to the Science stream when the students flocked blindly to engineering colleges, the dwindling numbers of teachers in the department as my senior colleagues retired one by one: these were issues that cast a shadow for quite a few years. But now admissions have picked up again and the teaching staff has been augmented by an influx of young teachers. During the last few years there has been a buzz of vibrant activity. The college is on the march again. May it attain ever increasing glory and greatness!

Let me sign off by wishing my students and young colleagues bright careers and happy lives. To my senior colleagues and friends, I offer my best wishes for their health and happiness and my grateful thanks for their friendship. To Madam Principal and the Management, my sincere gratitude for a rewarding career.


Message

26 July 2018


Havan Yajna was performed to seek divine blessings. The pious ceremony enriched the environment with positivity and provided a sacred onset to the session.
