संदेश



INTRODUCTION

The inception of Arya College, Ludhiana in **1946** was the fulfilment of a long cherished desire of the people of Ludhiana and its surrounding areas. A few dedicated and farsighted members of Arya Samaj came together in 1945 and pooled their wisdom to undertake the venture of opening a college to cater to the educational needs of the area. They set out with a missionary zeal to raise funds for the college. They not only made liberal financial contributions but also reached out to the people to get them involved in their mission. Their relentless efforts fructified in 1946, when Arya College came into existence.

When education for women became the need of the hour, a separate **girls wing** of the college was started in **1970**. New faculties were added from time to time. At present, the college offers three year degree course in Arts, Science (Medical & Non-Medical), Commerce & Business Management, Computer Science & Applications, Business Administration and two year post graduate course in History, Political Science, Punjabi, M.Com and M.Sc. (IT). M.A. in Hindi, Sanskrit and Music (Vocal) are in pipeline. The college is also running one year diploma courses in PGDCA, PGDMM and PGDTT. For the convenience of the students who pursue B.Com and C.A. simultaneously, early morning classes have been started.

If the college has contributed significantly to the cause of education and social uplift, its students have also not lagged behind in bringing laurels to the college and the country. Its alumni have spread the values they imbibed in the college and have made their mark in various fields of academics, sports, politics, business and administration. **Sunil Bharti Mittal**, one of the top ten businessmen of the country, **Pankaj Kapoor**, a renowned film actor, and a good number of political leaders like **S.Sharanjit Singh Dhillon**, Olympians like **S.Sukhbir Singh Grewal and Hardeep Singh Grewal**, International weight lifters like **Sh.Parvesh Kumar** and Cricketers like **Sh.Yash Pal Sharma, Balkar Singh Sandhu (Mayor), Bharat Bhushan Ashu (Cabinet Minister)** have brightened the name of the country on the horizons of the world.

LOCATION AND BUILDING

The main college as well as its girls wing is centrally located in Civil Lines on Maharishi Dayanand Road. The girls wing is located at a short distance from the main college. It is housed in a spacious building adjacent to the building of Dayanand Medical College. The buildings of both the wings of the college are tastefully designed and bear an architectural grandeur. The building of the main college is spread over about 10 acre tract of land. It has spacious science laboratories equipped with modern apparatus, separate and attractive library block having three reading-rooms and extensive play-grounds for all major games. All the lecture rooms are well-furnished and commodious. Water-coolers fitted with RO system provide pure drinking water to staff and students. Two high powered generators have been installed in the main college and one in the girls section for uninterrupted supply of electricity in the class rooms. The additional attractions of the college building are: a state-of-the-art gymnasium, a recently beautified auditorium, an ultra modern computer lab equipped with Apple computers, newly renovated administrative block and a fully air conditioned seminar room.

- The merit list will be displayed on the date of admission at 9:30 a.m. The admission will be on merit basis till the availability of seats.
- The Students may also apply online for various courses.

General Instructions For Admission

1. A student with compartment/reappear in two subjects in 10+2 is not eligible for admission to the college.
2. Compartment cases of other Universities/Boards are not eligible to seek admission to any class in the college even if they clear compartment in September.
3. Students whose result is declared late by the University/Board may join within 15 days after the publication of the result. The students who have been placed under compartment in the university examination are admitted to the next higher class provisionally.
4. Candidate with a gap in his/her studies shall not be admitted to any class unless he/she explains the gap satisfactorily and submits an affidavit stating that he/she was not involved in any criminal act during the gap period.
5. Students of other colleges who have failed in a class will not be admitted to the college.
6. Local migration may be allowed in rare cases on very valid reasons.
7. If, due to an omission, any unauthorised subject combination has been allowed at any stage to a student, it will be treated as automatically cancelled.
8. The college may not impart instruction in a subject/discipline if the strength of students in that subject/discipline is less than ten.
9. **Where the rules of the Boards/Universities are silent, the orders of the Principal shall be final.**

PROCEDURE OF ADMISSION

Application for admission must be made on the prescribed application form issued with the college prospectus. The applicant should fill in the application form in his/her own handwriting. **The students may also apply online at www.aryacollegeludhiana.in.**

The application must be accompanied by original and attested copies of:

- (i) A character certificate from the Head of the institution last attended.
- (ii) A copy of Aadhaar Card.
- (iii) Matriculation certificate showing the Date of Birth.
- (iv) Certificates of all the examinations passed.
- (v) University/Board Registration card in the case of those already registered with University/Board
- (vi) Migration certificate in the case of students migrating from other universities.
- (vii) Three Passport size photographs (one to be affixed on the application form, one on the computer sheet and one to be attached to the application form).

Candidates belonging to S.C./B.C. classes are required to submit in addition: (a) Attested copy of Scheduled Caste Certificate. (b) Affidavit by Father/Guardian in respect to annual income of the family. **In the case of gap year the student will furnish an affidavit making a solemn declaration that during the gap he was neither disqualified nor involved in any criminal case.**

Students placed in compartment in 10+2 will submit their original detailed marks card. Students coming from foreign universities will have to obtain eligibility certificate from the Panjab University, Chandigarh. No incomplete form will be entertained. **Candidates must present themselves in person at the time of admission.**

Note: The College reserves the right to refuse admission to any student or disallow any combination of subjects/options.

RULES FOR PAYMENT OF COLLEGE DUES

1. At the time of admission, tuition fee for 12 months along with Panjab University charges/D.P.I. (Colleges) charges & miscellaneous college annual charges, will be collected from the students.
2. Fee/Fines and other charges once paid shall not be refunded for any reason.
3. The schedule of charging college dues is put up well in time before the date prescribed for payment of such dues. A fine of Rs.50/- per day is charged for late payment unless the student seeks permission of the Principal before the due date of payment.
4. The names of students who do not pay their fees within 15 days of the due date are removed from the rolls. They may be re-admitted on payment of Rs.250/- as Re-admission Fee along with the late fee fine. The Principal may, at his/her discretion, refuse to re-admit a student without assigning any reason for the same.

5. If a student leaves without getting his/her name withdrawn from the college, complete charges for 12 months will have to be paid by him/her.
6. Security deposit will be refunded to the depositor within six months after leaving the college provided he/she has cleared all the college dues. No application for refund of security will be entertained after the expiry of the time limit.

CONCESSIONS AND STIPENDS

Stipends and concessions in the tuition fee are granted to the students on the basis of annual income, merit, good result and distinction in sports and co-curricular activities.

Brother/Sister concession is granted to a student on the production of a certificate to this effect.

The student has to apply for fee-concession on the prescribed form available from the college office by the date notified vide an office order. In order to ensure that the concession is given to genuine & deserving students, an affidavit from the parents declaring their annual income is the basis of the granting of stipend. No application is entertained after the prescribed date.

Subject to the policy of the State Government, all SC students belonging to the State of Punjab will be exempted from the payment of tuition fee under the Harijan Welfare Scheme.

Students scoring 95% and above marks in 10+2 and seeking admission in the college will be given a concession of Rs.5000/- p.a. Students scoring 90% and above marks in 10+2 and seeking admission in the college will be given a concession of Rs.2,000/- p.a.

CHANGE OF SUBJECT

Students are permitted to change any elective subject within one month from the commencement of the session on payment of fee of Rs.200/- only. Students wishing to change a subject shall have to apply on the form prescribed for this purpose.

Note: No change in subject is permitted after the due date.

LEAVE RULES

Leave of absence from the college should be applied personally by

a student on the prescribed printed form available from the college office. In case of illness, the application should be supported with a medical certificate. For absence without leave, a fine will be imposed. The name of the student who remains absent for more than 10 days without giving any information is struck off. His re-admission is allowed with the permission of the Principal and after the payment of Rs.250/- as re-admission fee.

MID-SEMESTER TESTS (MST)

One Mid-Semester Test (MST) will be held per semester.

Every student must take the MST to enable himself/herself to become eligible for appearing in the university examination.

Absentees from the MST will be fined as per college rules.

The Principal has the discretion to change the schedule of the MST.

Internal Assessment in each paper will be given to the students on the basis of the marks obtained by them in the MST and their attendance of lectures as per the University norms.

RULES FOR ADMISSION TO UNIVERSITY EXAMINATION

A student shall be eligible to appear in the University examination if he/she:

- (i) has attended 75% of the full course of lectures and practicals arranged for his/her class in each subject.
- (ii) has obtained at least 25% marks in aggregate of all subjects in the MST.

IDENTITY CARD & LIBRARY MEMBERSHIP CARD

All students on the rolls of the college are issued laminated identity cards on joining the college. After a student is issued the receipt for the fee paid by him, he should get himself photographed by the official photographer of the college. He should collect his laminated identity card on a date and time given to him by the photographer.

On the presentation of the identity card, the student will be issued the Library Membership Card. Books from the library are issued to the student on the production of both these cards. Students are required to always keep their identity cards with them. These are non-transferable. These must be produced when demanded to be checked by any official of the college. For Railway and bus passes; the identity card is a must. If a student loses his/her identity/library membership card, he/she can be issued a duplicate card on payment of Rs. 50/- and Rs.25/- respectively. Misuse of identity card, or any alteration or manipulation in it, will be viewed as a serious criminal offence and entails deterrent punishment.

LIBRARY AND READING ROOM

The college has a well-equipped air-conditioned library with

reading rooms. The college subscribes to a large number of Indian and foreign journals and periodicals in Hindi, Punjabi, English, Science, Computer Science, Commerce and Social Sciences. The library remains open during college hours.

EDUCATIONAL TOURS

Educational tours are arranged in every semester to acquaint the students with places of educational and historical importance. Students will deposit money for it with the office only after a notice to this effect has been put up on the Notice Board under the signature of the Principal. The college is not responsible for any student joining any tour within or outside the country, organised privately.



CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Special attention is paid to co-curricular activities in order to develop the talents of students and to provide them opportunities for self-expression and to inculcate in them a sense of responsibility, discipline and capacity for initiative, organisation and leadership.

The Subject Societies organise programmes in their respective subjects which include declamation contests, debates, poetical symposia, recitation contests, story competitions and quiz competitions.

Under the aegis of Dept. of CCA, students are prepared for theatrical items i.e. Music, Dance and Drama, Literary items i.e. creative writing, elocution etc. and Heritage items.

Through a Talent hunt competition organised every year, the students are selected to represent the college in Inter-College and Inter-Zonal youth festivals.

EXTENSION LECTURES

Extension lectures on various subjects by eminent scholars are arranged to enable the students to broaden their outlook and acquaint them with the developments in the world around them and also the latest streams of thought in their subjects.



YOUTH WELFARE DEPARTMENT

Youth Welfare Department has been set up in the college. Students are encouraged to participate in Hiking, Trekking, Mountaineering, Basic and Advanced Leadership Training Camps and other youth welfare activities organised by the Youth Service Department of the Punjab Government and the Panjab University. The department also regularly undertakes projects of social service and youth welfare.

COLLEGE MAGAZINE

A college magazine, 'The Aryan' with News, Hindi, Punjabi, Sanskrit, English, Science, Commerce and Computer sections is published once a year. Each section is under the charge of a Staff Editor, under whose supervision a Student Editor functions. The magazine mirrors creativity, talent and achievements of the students.

GAMES, SPORTS & PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Special efforts are made by the college authorities to promote sports. The college has a well-equipped gymnasium and extensive and well-maintained playgrounds. Facilities exist for Hockey, Football, Cricket, Volleyball, Softball, Badminton, Table-Tennis, Kabbadi, Weight-lifting, Body-building, Kho-Kho and Athletics.

Teams are constituted through regular selection by the college Sports Committee in the beginning of the session. These are entered for various University Tournaments. Annual Sports and Athletics Meet is held every year. Professional Sportsmen/ Athletes/Players are not entertained.

Sports persons who are national level winners will be offered freship.

No fee concession shall be given to a student merely on the basis of his

becoming a member of a team.

Note: The credit for admission or any concession on the basis of achievements in sports will be given only on the basis of the certificates issued in this regard by the sports authorities of the Punjab Government or Panjab University.

NATIONAL CADET CORPS (NCC)

The college has a unit of N.C.C. (Air Wing). The students of 1st semester of any stream have the option to enroll in NCC after clearing the Common Entrance Test and interview conducted by Unit no.4 Pb. Air Sqn. The enrolled students are required to deposit a refundable security to the Unit as per rules.

NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME (NSS)

The college has introduced NSS to promote the cause of national reconstruction in three spheres, i.e. adult education, slum clearance and eradication of diseases. For the implementation of these programmes, reconstruction projects are taken in hand. Camps are organised to provide opportunity to the students for social service. The students taking NSS are awarded special certificates by the University which help them in admission to the next higher class and for getting government jobs.

HEALTH & MEDICAL AID

The college maintains a dispensary under the charge of a qualified doctor. The college ensures effective medical check-up of students and provides them with medical aid. The dispensary remains open during the working hours of the college.



COLLEGE CANTEEN

The college canteen caters to students with a variety of snacks, hot and cold beverages at reasonable rates. The students are required to ensure that the facility made available to them is utilised properly and no ugly scene is created there.

PARKING OF TWO-WHEELERS

1. Students must place their two wheelers in the shed meant for the purpose.
2. It is compulsory for students to lock their cycles/scooters before leaving the shed. Students will get a token to be affixed permanently on their vehicles.
3. The College will not be responsible for the loss of any vehicle. No parking facility will be provided to students for cars or other four wheelers.

PRIZES

Students who distinguish themselves in studies, sports, N.C.C., N.S.S. or other co-curricular activities are awarded prizes, college colour and certificates of merit at the Annual Prize Distribution Function subject to their otherwise satisfactory conduct. **A cash prize of Rs.5,100/- will be awarded to the University topper in academics of every semester. Also cash prizes of Rs.3,100/- and Rs.2,100/- will be awarded to students who secure second and third positions respectively in Panjab University. Other university merit position holders will be awarded Rs.1,100/- each. Student with 100% attendance will be awarded Rs.1,100/-. Sports persons who are national level winners will be awarded Rs.21,000/-. Intervarsity gold medal winners will be awarded Rs.11,000/-. Silver medal winners Rs.7,500/- and Bronze medal winners Rs.5,000/- respectively.**

COLLEGE ROLL OF HONOUR

The privilege of signing the Roll of Honour is conferred on those students of final year who have some extraordinary achievements to their credit in the sphere of studies, sports or co-curricular activities at the university or state level.

DISCIPLINE

The authority of the college extends over students on its rolls at all the places and at all hours. It is expected from them to behave in a manner which enhances the prestige of the college. Misbehavior or delinquency of any kind, which in the judgement of the Principal, lowers the image of the college or vitiates its atmosphere, will be appropriately dealt with and may even involve suspension, rustication or expulsion from the college. Any one found damaging or tampering with college property is liable to disciplinary action of a serious nature. The students should be courteous and polite in their dealings with one another and with the employees of the college. They must maintain proper decorum and silence in the classrooms, the library, the reading rooms and the campus. Students are not allowed to hold any meeting on the premises of the college without the prior permission of the Principal. Students are expected to be regular and practical in their attendance. Smoking, drinking and taking non-vegetarian preparations in the college premises are strictly prohibited.

Use of mobile phone in the classroom and corridors is strictly banned. Defaulters shall be fined Rs.500/-. Ragging in any form is

strictly banned in the college premises. Defaulters shall be handed over to the police.

Students who fail to qualify the eligibility conditions pertaining to lectures and MSTs will not be entitled to any prize, certificate of merit, scholarship, fee concession, College Colour and Roll of Honour.

Parents / Guardians can contact the Office Supdt. of the college to update themselves about their wards' attendance and their performance in MSTs from time to time.

3. The admission stands cancelled in case the fee is not deposited on the same day.


